The plan will examine and put forward sites suitable for future development and it will set the design standard of all new extensions and development. It will also include our views on the preservation of any key heritage features and improvements to Parish facilities.

The Plan, once approved will become part of CDC and the SDNP adopted Local Plan and will be referred to by CDC and SDNP when making planning decisions in our Parish.
